Dear Staff Member or Volunteer,

It has been determined that someone at your school tested positive for COVID-19. To slow the spread of COVID-19 in our schools and community, Davis County Health Department has provided the following recommendations:

You have been boosted
OR have received both
doses of either the
Pfizer or Moderna
vaccine less than 5
months ago OR a dose
of J&J vaccine less than
2 months ago OR had a
confirmed infection of
COVID-19 in the last
90 days,



You can continue to come to school, but should wear a mask around others for 10 days.

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If possible, get tested 5 days after your exposure to be sure you are not positive.



If you do develop symptoms, stay home and get tested.

You have not been fully vaccinated OR boosted OR received your Pfizer or Moderna vaccine more than 5 months ago OR your J&J vaccine more than 2 months ago,



You should quarantine for 5 days. After that, you can return to school, but should wear a mask for 5 additional days.



If possible, get tested 5 days after your exposure to be sure you are not positive.



If you do develop symptoms, stay home and get tested.

Alternatively, if you do not have symptoms, you can attend school in a mask for 10 days.

If you get symptoms of COVID-19 after being exposed to someone who tested positive, stay home and get tested, even if their symptoms are mild or you have been vaccinated. For testing locations, visit coronavirus.utah.gov/testing-locations or contact your healthcare provider.
