## SAFE SCHOOL POLICY

## Safe Schools Policy

CSLA shall provide a safe environment for all students through close supervision within all school buildings and on all school grounds. In addition, special attention will be made to the following objectives:

- Maintaining a safe school environment.
- Emphasizing safe practices on the part of school personnel and students, particularly in those areas of instruction or extracurricular activities that offer special hazards.
- Providing first-aid care for students in case of accident or sudden illness.

Administration and Staff of CSLA expect each student to abide by the following standards of behavior:

- Students will not cause or attempt to cause damage to school or private property or steal school or private property.
- Students will not cause, attempt to cause, or threaten to cause physical injury to another person.
- Students will not have in their possession, sell, or otherwise furnish any firearm, knife, explosive, controlled substances, alcohol, or other item considered inappropriate.
- Students will not commit an obscene act, or engage in habitual profanity, or vulgarity.
- Students will not cause disruption to school activities, instructional programs, or other aspects of the school day.
- Students will not willfully defy the valid authority of school personnel.
