


This form is used by trade schools, colleges, and universities to determine a student's eligibility for the following financial aid:

- · federal,
- state, and/or
- school-sponsored (college or trade)

According to NY Times, "the high school class of 2021 left an estimated \$3.7 billion in available Pell Grants unclaimed by failing to file the FAFSA application."





Why is it important?



- Nearly all students who fill out the FAFSA or CADAA qualify for some form of federal or state financial aid or college-based grants
- Seniors who complete the FAFSA are 84% more likely to immediately enroll in postsecondary education.
- In California, only 53% of high school seniors completed a FAFSA or a CADAA in the 2021-2022. California currently ranks 17th in the country.







AB 469: FAFSA & CADAA Completion Requirement

California Student Aid Commission notified all School Districts they are required to ensure that High School SENIORS complete & submit the

FAFSA or CADAA Application.
