



POLICY TITLE: STUDENT ATTENDANCE

Policy Type: Executive Limitations

Legal Citation: R277-607, Truancy Prevention

The School realizes students will succeed when they regularly, punctually attend school.

Accordingly, the School Director shall not:

1. Fail to develop truancy procedures that encourage regular, punctual attendance of students.
2. Fail to review the Truancy Policy annually.
3. Fail to define "approved school activity", "excused absence", and other definitions not provided in law necessary to implement a compulsory attendance policy.

4. Fail to include criteria and procedures for preapproval of extended absences.
5. Fail to establish programs and meaningful incentives which promote regular, punctual student attendance.
6. Fail to notify parents of the Truancy Policy, procedures, discipline, consequences, and appeal processes.
7. Fail to establish and publish procedures for students or parents to contest notices of truancy.
