IPM Statement

It is the goal of Fallbrook Union High School District to implement IPM by focusing on long-term prevention or suppression of pests through accurate pest identification, by frequent monitoring for pest presence, by applying appropriate action levels, and by making the habitat less conductive to pests using sanitation and mechanical and physical controls. Pesticides that are effective will be used in a manner that minimizes risks to people, property, and the environment, and only after other options have been shown ineffective.

Our pest management objectives are to:

- Keep all areas on campus as clean and sanitary as possible inside and out.
- Keep all buildings and foundations in good repair
- Keep all landscaping healthy, pruned, mowed, or mulched, and free of trash
- Keep all outside trash receptacles clean and emptied on a regular rotation throughout the day
