

Sophomore Year Course Registration Guide 2023-2024

Students must be enrolled in a *minimum* of seven courses per term/semester. Please follow the instructions below to aid in making your course selections. You may also refer to your transcript/credit evaluation for additional help.

Selection 1: English (4 credits required for graduation)
Please select: English 10 Honors or English 10

Selection 2: Mathematics (3 credits required for graduation)
Secondary Math II is required for graduation.

Selection 3: Science (3 credits required for graduation)

Students must earn a minimum of 2.0 credits from foundational science courses, but may complete the remaining 1.0 credit from a foundational or applied option.

As a 10th grade student, you will be enrolled in Biology.

Selection 4: History (3 credits required for graduation)

Students must earn a minimum of 2.5 from foundational course options, but may complete the remaining .5 credit from any social studies area.

As a 10th grade student, you will take a full year of World History.

Selection 5: Physical Education (1.5 credits required for graduation) As a 10th grade student, you will take Fitness for Life in semester 1 and Lifetime Activities in semester 2. Fitness for Life is required for graduation.

Selection 6: Fine Arts (1.5 credits required for graduation)

Please select: At least one art course, depending on your schedule in 9th grade. You may choose from Art Foundations I or II, 3D Design/Fine Crafts I, Painting I or II, or Photography I or II. Please refer to the course catalog to ensure you've met any prerequisites. Art Foundations I is a prerequisite for all other art courses.

Selection 7: Other

Tenth grade students will take Financial Literacy (.5 credit) for one semester, Career Explorations (.5 credit) for one semester, and 21st Century Living (.25 credit) for one term.

To graduate, you must have a minimum of 24 credits.
