

What to do if your student has food allergies?

If your student(s) has an allergy to food and needs a modification to school lunch the Nutrition Director needs an allergy form completed by you and your student's doctor. This will allow us to make accommodations to our menu to best suit your student's allergy needs.

- Pick up an allergy form from the office, or you can print one off at home. They are located on our school website.
- Return completed form to the office, they will make sure that the Nutrition Director receives it.
- Once received the Nutrition Director will call you and go over the form. This will give us a chance to discuss our program and answer any questions you may have.

What does lunch look like for your allergy student?

- You and your student will look over the menu and decide which days they want to eat school lunch.
- Email those days to the Nutrition Director. We need those days at least a week in advance. We only make allergy meals by request.
- When your student comes through the lunch line they give us their name, we will make sure to get them their accommodated meal.
