2014-2015 Plan:

Proposed ideas include: 1. Science program: 'Loose in the Lab' for 5-6 grades. Would be used for two years. 2. Laptops; enough for 5 laptops per classroom to use for common core and reading. 3. Software. 4. Writing curriculum.

Review: State Audit Report- Matt Lovell

Matt reviewed the 2013 state audit performed by Squire. The Ranches Academy complied with all requirements during the 2013 year.

Review and Vote: 2013-2014 Updated budget

Updated budget changes include: Gifted and Talented from \$1,358 to \$0.00, SPED from \$29,540 to \$25,540, Professional Training from \$12,000 to \$10,000, SPED Supplies from \$1,000 to \$3,000, Professional Development Supplies from \$4,000 to \$6,000, Software from \$5,000 to \$7,000.

Changes in the budget forecast include: Technology and Hardware from \$16,000 to \$21,073, Dues and Fees from \$5,000 to \$7,000 and Facility Payment from \$156,000 to \$166,000.
