Meals are the same for all children regardless of race, color, national origin, sex, age or disability, and there will be no discrimination in the course of the meal service. **Meals will be provided through December 31, 2020 or until available funds run out,** at the sites and times as follows:

Parents/Guardians of at home learners may continue to <u>pre-order</u> lunch for their student(s) and pick up daily from **11:30 a.m.** -**12:00 p.m**. using the google form emailed previously.

We encourage anyone who has not yet completed a free or reduced lunch application to do so because these benefits are temporary and will expire as stated above.

*Please note GFA will not serve meals over school breaks or holidays.
